Safeguarding Awareness Training

It is the expectation of the Bishop, Trustees and Safeguarding Commission that this initial training is undertaken and refreshed every three years. New Volunteers should undertake the Initial Training within the first year of being appointed. A Refresher Training Programme will be rolled out from September 2018 starting with those who did their training in 2015.
